<u>Maths:</u>

Next week we will be teaching All About the Number 8. Watching Numberblocks Series 2 Episode 8. We will learn the formation of 8 make an s and do not wait, when it's joined up you have an 8. Use numicon to help learn our number bonds to 8 e.g. 2+6, 3+5 etc. Find different ways of making 8p using coins practically e.g. 5p+2p+1p-2p+2p+2p and finally, subtraction up to 8. There are also lots of representations of 8 – we will be learning about these, too.

Tricky word mat: I will attach to this email the Tricky Word mat that we use, for your reference. Please begin with the Phase 2 words. Help your child learn to read them, then spell them, then write them in a simple sentence. You can then move on to Phase 3 words and so on. This will really benefit your child with their reading and writing.
