Maths:

Next week we will be learning about the numbers 15, 16 and 17. We will be learning number bonds to these numbers, one more/less, halves, odd/even, representing them on a ten frame, using numicon etc.

Phonics:

You could play a game where you say a sound from their Sound Mat and see if your child can write it down (remembering how to spell the sound e.g. th) Can they then write a word that has it in?
