

The Reception Round-up!


Some of the lovely things we have been learning this week:

We have read Each, pear, pear, plum and enjoyed hearing the rhyme. We played a game on the computer, matching rhyming words! We spotted the nursery rhymes and fairy tales in the book and did some activities to do with them. The children REALLY enjoyed making and tasting fruit crumble this afternoon.



Some of the things that children might experience next week:
