

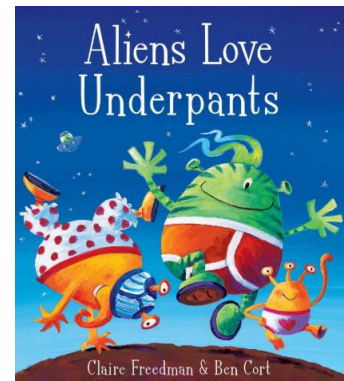
The Reception Round-up!
