## The new Early Years Framework

- Became statutory in September 2021
- Overarching principles set out by the DfE:
- Every child is a unique child, who is constantly learning and can be resilient, capable, confident and self-assured
- Children learn to be strong and independent through positive relationships
- Children learn and develop well in enabling environments with teaching and support from adults, who respond to their individual needs and help them to build their learning over time
- Importance of learning and development. Children develop and learn at different rates

- Personal, Social and Emotional Development
- Physical Development
- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Understanding the World
- Expressive Arts and Design

### How this works at Emscote

- We have updated our curriculum inline with the new EYFS
- Our topic based curriculum is varied Wonderful Wellies, cooking, extra music & PE from outside providers, daily phonics & maths sessions, indoor and outdoor play provision, experienced staff who are 'in' with the children building upon their individual next steps in learning
- There is less time spent on evidence collecting/Tapestry and moe time spent with the children
- We have a big focus on language development and PSED (Zones of Regulation)
- But first I'd like to quickly give you a visual flavour of Reception...






















































