Dear Parents and Carers,

Zones of Regulation:

Big emotions can be very overwhelming for children and this means that identifying and regulating these emotions can be a very big job. Across both of our schools, we are adopting a new way of helping children to understand their emotions in and out of school; this approach is called 'Zones of Regulation'. Attached to this email you'll find a handout with lots more information - it would be great if you could ask your children what they have learned so far in school. Children will be having a lesson each week on these 'Zones' so keep asking them what they have learned over the next few months.



Crocus Planting

The children have been planting them on the bank between the path (along Y5 and 6 classrooms) and the playground - that way everyone will get to see them!



Year 5 St John's Museum Trip

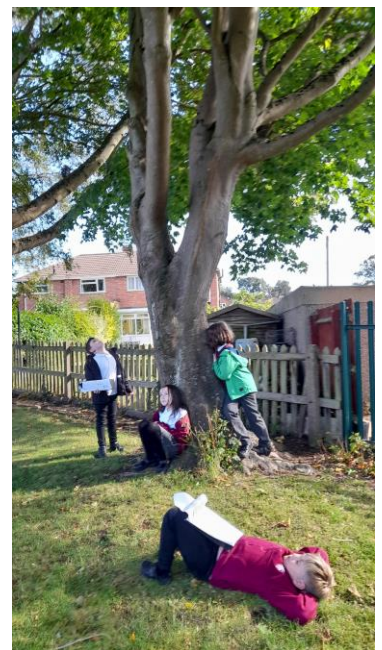
Year 5 spent the day at St John's Museum exploring Anglo Saxon artefacts and clothing.
