We will be starting **Christmas** activities! We are very excited. Christmas role play, crafts and practising our play in the hall!

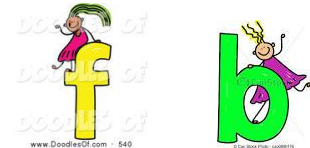


How you can help your child at home:
