Maths:

Next week we will be teaching the children their number bonds to 10.

We hope the children will have a quick mental recall of them. E.g. 5 and 5, 8 and 2, 7 and 3 etc

Something to work on

The children are getting very good recognising their sounds. Any practice you can do with your child to read words that have the digraphs in e.g. sh ee p = 'sheep' and ch i ck = 'chick' would be really helpful as some children are sounding these out like s h e e p without recognising the digraphs in them.



Topic:

We will be reading 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and discussing how the characters felt at different points in the story. The children will plant a bean during Wonderful Wellies and later in the week we will read 'Jim and the Beanstalk' and compare the books – similarities and differences. It would be wonderful if you could practice at home, your child re-telling 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.

What's going on this week/notices/information:

Homework: We wanted to give the children the chance to settled back this week. Next Thursday we will begin setting homework again. Please can you send your child in with their yellow homework book on **Monday** if you still have it at home. Each Monday homework is due in.
