Please help them find objects in your home or think of objects that begin with 's' or an 'a'.






Topic:

Reading packets:

Reading packets have been given out tonight, there is a wordless reading book in there with 2 words walls and a letter explaining how to enjoy a wordless book with your child. Please make sure these reading packets are in your child's bookbag each day, ready to read with us at any time.

Online Portal:

This year, we are going to use 'Seesaw' as an online platform. You will be able to see **some** of the things that the children are getting up to at school. We will be sending out more details about this in the next few weeks.

Spare clothes and wellies:

All children need to bring a pair of wellies and a named bag with spare clothes in to leave on their peg in school. Well done if you have already done so!

Milk:

If you haven't already done so, please register for 'Cool Milk' if your child would like milk. From their 5th birthday you will have to pay for them to have milk.

Birthdays:

We have a special Birthday tradition at Emscote! The children are allowed to wear their own clothes to school on their birthday. It means that everyone can wish them a Happy Birthday! If your child's birthday is at the weekend or during a holiday then they can wear their own clothes on the nearest Monday/Friday.
