#### New all-weather track

We are delighted to tell you that the installation of our new all-weather track has now been completed. It is not an athletics track with lanes for running but rather, an all-purpose track for doing daily mile/kids marathon running, cycling and scooting throughout the year. It is a fantastic addition to our facilities here and has only been possible through our PE budget funding and a grant from the council obtained through our PTA. Mr Payne has measured and calculated the maths - children will need to run 235 laps across next year in order to reach the goal of 26 miles, a full marathon!



#### Sports Day/ Week

During this week, the children did lots of Active Maths and English in class and also had their own year group sports day. As part of their sports day, the children were put into five countries linked to the upcoming Olympics. #### HAF Holiday Scheme

Ahead of the summer holidays, we wanted to let you know about the brilliant new Holiday Activities and Food programme which is operating in your local area. We are helping to launch a new film to promote the programme so parents know that their children can get involved in a local holiday club when the school term ends this July.

We know that the holidays can be a really difficult time for families who are struggling to make ends meet or who are juggling work and childcare. The holidays should be a time for every child to enjoy themselves rather than worrying about having enough to eat or how they can spend their free time.

That's why we're really excited about the summer holiday programmes that are being funded by the Government and will take place across the whole of England. This was recommended by the National Food Strategy when it was published last year. A petition supporting the recommendation was signed by over 1 million people.

Places on the holiday schemes are available for free to children who receive free school meals, but children and young people of all ages and backgrounds are welcome to attend. Each local programme will provide delicious, healthy meals, allow kids to get active, help them learn new things, make friends and have fun. And that is what the holidays are all about!

Organise lots of activities so every child can find something they enjoy - from Kung Fu and cooking to bushcraft.

Keep children and young people happy, healthy and active Offer a flexible childcare option for busy parents

#### Join the My School Fund initiative to help boost our budget

We're pleased to announce that All Saints' is part the My School Fund initiative. This innovative scheme allows us to boost our school's budget with your help.

#### How does it work?

Parents, guardians and carers can sign up to the scheme for free and start earning cashback on the things they buy in participating retail stores, including Sainsbury's and Argos. As you spend you'll receive 2% cashback in the form of eGift vouchers that can be redeemed in participating stores. By adding a credit/debit card and linking your spend to our school on the My School Fund website we'll also earn 1% cashback on your spend.

#### Adding a credit/debit card

Once you have registered you will be asked to link a card to your My School Fund account. This information is protected using bank level encryption. The site does not ask you to provide any card information that will allow anyone to make a payment on your card - i.e. it does not ask for the card security code (CVC or CVV). More information about data protection and security is available in the FAQs section of the My School Fund website when you are logged in to your account.

#### Transforming Communities Together Development Free Frozen Food Hamper

There will be another summer holiday frozen food hamper drop for families eligible for free school meals from All Saints church carpark as usual at the end of term. If you would like to book a hamper please let the school office know by 14<sup>th</sup> July.

The hampers will contain 6 frozen pork and beef butchery items (e.g. sausages, burgers, joint, strips, diced, mince) and a fresh veg bag. Each item will come with a short cooking video accessed through a QR code to help you to cook a healthy nutritious meal with each item.

We'll also be providing an activity bag for each child with the hampers so would appreciate numbers of children per household.

We are also planning a September hamper drop to help parents through the expensive back to school period. We are planning this Wednesday 8th and Thursday 9th September, more details will be given nearer the time.
