#### Maths

## Topic

We will be learning about the works of favourite artists, craft makers and designers. History will celebrate the lives of significant individuals who in the past have contributed to national and international achievements.



## Literacy

This term is a revision term where we are finely tuning all of our newly acquired skills and making sure that we can use them correctly in our written work. This includes:

- Using a/an
- Contractions (can't, I'm)
- Adverbs, verbs, nouns, adjectives
- Questions and exclamations
- Conjunctions (and, but, or, because) in the middle of a sentence

We will be covering a range of writing including fiction and non-fiction.

## Phonics Screening

### PE

On Thursday afternoons, both Oak and Chestnut will be doing dance with 'Fiery Feet'. On Friday afternoons, they will be playing 'Kwik Kricket' and will need their outdoor P.E kits.

### Science

This term the main focuses will be plants and seasonal changes. The children will learn to identify a variety of common garden and wild plants and trees. For the seasonal changes focus, we will observe the differences in weather and length of days as the seasons change.
