## Some of the lovely things we have been learning this week:



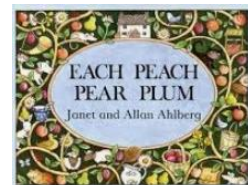

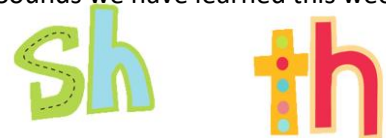
## Some of the things that children might experience next week:

Next week we will be reading *Each, Peach, Pear, Plum* and learning about rhyme as well as reading the fairy tales and singing the nursery rhymes involved too!

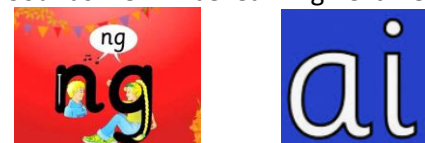


During Wonderful Wellies next week, the children will be keeping birds healthy, by making them bird feeders!
