<u>Maths:</u>

What's going on this week/notices/information:

Willow class assembly: We hope you enjoyed their assembly. We felt so proud of them and the children were so excited to share it with you!

Trip to Brandon Marsh: We are very excited about our trip to Brandon Marsh on Monday. Please send your child wearing their school uniform and a rain coat.
