Title of Book

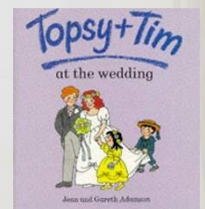
'Topsy and Tim at the wedding' by Jean & Garath Adamason
