REPORT ON FUNDRAISING 2018/19

We are delighted to announce that last year was our most successful fundraising year ever, raising **£11,124.67** (£5,091.85 for All Saints' and £6,032.82 for Emscote). Children from both schools have been enjoying the benefits of spending all that we raised. Successful fundraising included the Christmas and summer fayres, raffles, children's artwork on mugs/tea towels, discos, a bingo night and our fireworks' event.

We would like to say a massive thank you to all children and their families for their contributions either helping out or attending one of our events. Let's hope 2019/20 is just as successful!

REPORT ON SPENDING

Last year, our spending has included £100 for each class at both schools, a Christmas pantomime and fun leavers' celebrations for our year 2 and year 6 children.

At Emscote we funded a special Chinese New Year assembly, purchased new carpets for the year 1 classes to help with sitting, bought Christmas presents and supported the Christmas party (including a visit from Father Christmas). We funded a visit from a touring theatre company who performed The Wizard of Oz, supported a trip to Ryton Pools and activities for reception in the summer term and funded the ongoing upkeep of the resident chickens. We also contributed £600 towards the end of year, whole school trip to Twycross Zoo. At **All Saints'** we contributed £640 towards trips in the summer term, purchased much needed blinds for classroom windows, bought new musical instruments and art resources, as well as over £300 worth of books for the literacy corner and personalised Year 6 Leavers' t-shirts and treats for year 6 as they left the school.

This year, we've already committed to supporting regular events such as the visiting pantomime and trips, class money and Christmas presents. We need your support to ensure that we can continue to fund these and many other special activities for the children throughout the year.



FIREWORKS EVENING

We are holding our exciting fireworks event again this Autumn. The event will take place between **5.00 and 7.00pm on Thursday 7th November** at All Saints' School for families from both schools.

There will be hot food available between 5.30pm and 6.30pm and the firework display will start at 6.50pm. Tickets will cost £4.00 per adult and £2.00 per child, with all children under school age free. Tickets will be limited for safety reasons and will be sold on a first come first served basis. We have sold out the last 3 years so to avoid disappointment complete the attached form and return your money to the office as soon as possible.

The PTA are looking for a new chair for the academic year 2019/20 and have been discussing how the committee needs to evolve now that the Emscote and All Saints teams have successfully merged into one.

We are going to establish a year group representative system whereby each year has 2/3 parents who the PTA can turn to when organising events. For the fairs, each year will be given the responsibility of a particular stall/task and the class reps will be responsible for leading this with other parents in that year.
