Dear Parents / Carers,

To ensure the smooth running of school from September 2nd, please take a moment to read this letter containing all the information you will need for sending your child/ren to school. *Even if your children have already been attending there have been changes to the current system so it is important you read this.*

- Children are required to wear school uniform and will require their PE kits.

 Please also bring clothing suitable for the weather because we will be going outside as much as possible, rain or shine.
- We ask children to bring their own snacks and drinks bottle (this will be refilled throughout the day by a member of staff) and to only bring items that they can open themselves.
- You are welcome to provide your child with their own packed lunch.
- Packed lunches are to be clearly marked with child's name and their year group.
- School lunches for the first half term will be in the form of hot Deli Bags which will be brought to the children in their classrooms. There will be no choice of contents (please see hot deli bag menu attached). School lunches will be charged at the usual rate unless you are eligible for Free School Meals.
- Children will be kept in their own 'year group bubble' with, as far as possible the same staff.
- There will be a staggered entry in the morning and at the end of the day to avoid the other bubbles.
- Movement around school by staff and children will be limited as far as possible.
- Playtimes will be staggered and children will stay in their own outdoor areas and will not be allowed to mix with children from a different year group bubble, and will be socially distant within their bubble.
- Children will need wellies and coats in school everyday as they will be using the field.
- Children will not be expected to be socially distant from their peers within a year group bubble. However, they will need to be socially distant from adults as much as possible.

Dropping off

- Please wait in cars with your children until you see a member of staff.
- If children are walking to school please line up with social distancing and wait on the spots provided.
- Please do not arrive early or late your child will not be allowed into school late due to crossing of bubbles.

Collection

• Depending on your collection and drop off arrangements (See below) please only send one parent per child to pick up and stay in your cars where possible until you see a member of staff at the gates. We want to avoid gatherings of adults. Please can you keep your child with you when lining up.
