We are SO proud of how well the children have started school this week! They have listened carefully to the routines and instructions and we have really enjoyed showing them around and getting to know them. What super stars!


Maths:

Next week in Maths, the children will be learning about **matching and sorting** objects. We will be encouraging them to explain their reasoning and understanding.

Phonics:

Next week in Phonics, the children will be focusing on developing their speaking and listening skills as well as thinking about environmental sounds, instrumental sounds, making body percussion (e.g. clapping and stamping), rhythm and rhyme and the sounds we can make with our voices. By securing these skills, children are more likely to be able to hear the individual sounds in words, which mean children find it much easier to spell and blend sounds when reading and writing.

Next week our theme will be **'Elmer'** the patchwork elephant.

We will be learning about colour, being unique, story sequencing and making a fabulous Elmer of our own!

Phonics, PSED, Music, SMSC, Wonderful Wellies, P.E. and Singing sessions all begin too!

Timings for next week:
