WHAT TO KNIT?

Instructions for knitting a 10 inch square

- Use double knit (DK) green yarn (any shade) on 6mm needles.
- Cast on 40 stitches.
- Garter stitch only (all rows) until work measures 10 inches (approx. 70 rows). Cast off.

4mm needles may be used, but adjust number of stitches and rows.

Instructions for experienced knitters

- Knit (or crochet) Christmas tree decorations - all shapes and sizes.
- Not too small, and no bigger than 10 inches tall.

Ideas for younger people

- Knit smaller squares, make pom-poms as baubles, French knitting tinsel...
