How you can help your child at home:

As we are beginning to near the end of our reception year we are starting to think about end of year expectations. To reach the expected level in Writing children need to be able to independently write simple sentences that can be read by themselves and others. In Maths children need to be able to count reliably with numbers from 1 to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than each number. They need to add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer.
