
# Easter Hunt fun:

#### Maths:

During the first week back, we will be learning about building numbers beyond 10. So we will use practical resources to see how the numbers 'grow' and ten frames, numicon, towers of cubes, etc. This will support the children to see that larger numbers are composed of full 10s and part of the next 10.



#### Phonics:

During the summer term we will be recapping the Phase 2 and Phase 3 sounds and tricky words. Please continue to practice their sounds and reading.

## Topic:

Our new theme next half term will be 'Animals'. We will begin with the story of 'Farmer Duck' and learning about farm animals. The children will make observations about the different animals - similarities, differences and share their experiences.

Please take some time to make sure your child is forming their letters in the correct way and starting in the correct place!
