<u>Maths:</u>

Next week we will be learning about doubling. We hope the children will gain a quick recall of doubling numbers to 10.

E.g. double 4 is 8.

Phonics:

We have been continuing to recap phase 2 and 3 sounds. Please continue lots of practice writing sentences encouraging your child to use their sounds and clear finger spaces.

<u>Topic:</u>

Next week we are reading Julia Donaldson's 'Tyrannosaurus Drip'. We will focus on the rhyme and carry out lots of fun dinosaur themed activities!

<u>Caterpillars</u>

We have some caterpillars that we will watch turn into beautiful butterflies! The children have really enjoyed looking at the caterpillars this week. They are growing big and strong, ready to form their cocoons.
