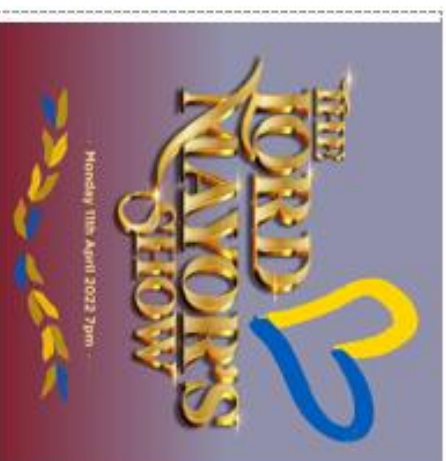
We have lots of fun for the whole family at THE ALBANY THEATRE this Easter and beyond.


