Topic:

Phonics practice: In your child's book bag is a Phase 2 and 3 sound mat. We would like your child to practice recognising and writing these sounds (particularly the digraphs) as much as possible. Your child could also practice writing the digraph sounds in words, for example, **sh: shark, shop, shin, shut** etc. We have learnt all of Phase 2 and most of Phase 3 – we have not yet learnt **ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er.** If you are worried that your child is finding it particularly tricky to recall the sounds then please do speak to us after half term!
