
INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

All Saints' C of E Junior School and Emscote Infant School Federation

1. The name of the Federation is the **All Saints' C of E Junior School and Emscote Infant School Federation**.
2. The names and categories of the schools within the federation are:
 - All Saints' C of E Junior School** – Voluntary Controlled
 - Emscote Infant School** – Community School
3. The name of the governing board is **All Saints' C of E Junior School and Emscote Infant School Federated Governing Board**
4. The governing board shall consist of:
 - 1 Headteacher**
 - 3 Foundation governors (including ex-officio governor)**
 - 1 Staff governor**
 - 1 Local Authority governor**
 - 2 Parent governors**
 - 10 Co-opted governors**
5. The total number of governors will be **18**
6. The term of office for all governors shall be **four** years
7. Parent governors will be elected as follows:
 - One parent governor from Emscote Infant School – start date September 2015
 - One parent governor from All Saints' C of E Junior School – start date September 2015
8. Foundation governors shall be appointed by the Coventry Diocesan Board of Education in consultation with the **Parochial Church Council of All Saints, Emscote, Warwick**

- a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio: the incumbent of the parish
 - b) The Diocesan Director of Education and the appropriate Archdeacon shall appoint a foundation governor to act in place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in a) above, in the event that the ex-officio governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations
9. The Diocesan Director of Education and the appropriate Archdeacon are entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor
 10. Statement of Religious Ethos:

All Saints' is a Church of England School, and its values are determined by the Christian ethos. It seeks to be distinctively Christian, yet inclusive of people of all faiths and none. It is part of the family of Church Schools within the Diocese of Coventry and is supported by the Diocesan Board of Education
 11. This Instrument of Government comes into effect on **3rd July 2023**
 12. This Instrument was made by order of Warwickshire Local Authority on **13th October 2023**
 13. This variation takes effect on **13th October 2023**
 14. A copy of this Instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing board (and the Headteacher if not a governor), the trustees of the foundation of the schools within the federation and the Diocesan Director of Education for Coventry Diocesan Board of Education
