## Spring Term Our Fabric Faces

### Key Vocabulary

#### Fabric & Materials

- **Fabric** – cloth used to make things
- **Yarn** – thick thread used for sewing or decoration
- **Thread** – thin material used for stitching
- **Textiles** – another word for cloth materials

#### Tools & Safety

- **Scissors** – used to cut fabric (with **safety rules**)
- **Needle** – tool used to sew fabric
- **Pin cushion** – keeps needles safe between uses

#### Techniques

- **Stitching** – sewing pieces of fabric together
- **Running Stitch** – simple in-and-out stitch for joining fabrics
- **Joining** – fastening two pieces of fabric together

#### Design & Evaluate

- **Design** – to plan how it will look and work
- **Evaluate** – to think about how well the finished product works
- **Improve** – make changes to make it better
