## Autumn Term Mark Making

### Key Vocabulary

**Line** A mark made by a pencil, pen, brush, etc. going from one point to another.

**Pattern** A design where lines, shapes or marks repeat.

**Texture** How something feels or looks like it would feel (rough, smooth, bumpy).

**Media/Medium** The materials you use to make marks (e.g. pencil, chalk, paint, crayon).

**Materials** The things you use to make your art or marks (paper, charcoal, crayons, etc.).

**Brushstroke** The mark made by a paintbrush when you move it across paper.

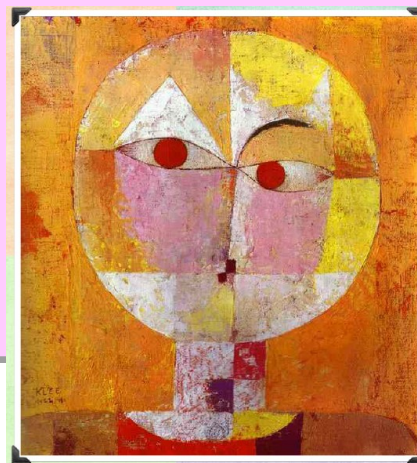
**Technique** A special way or method of making a mark or using a material.

**Imitate** To copy or try to do something in the same way as someone else (e.g. copy an artist's style).

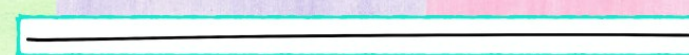

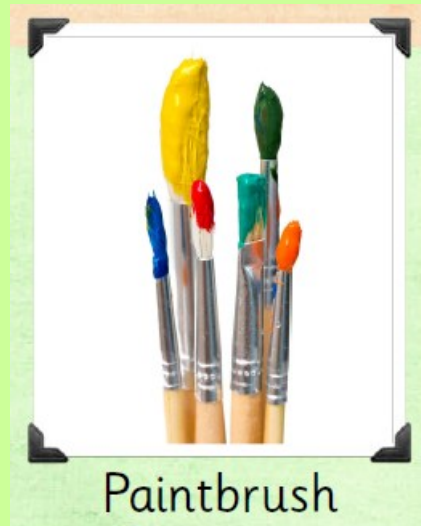
