### Key Vocabulary

**Material** What something is made from, like wood, stone or paper.

**Natural** Something that comes from nature, not made by people

**Colour** What we see when we look at things — like red, blue, or green.

**Shape** The form or outline of something, like a circle or square

**Pattern** A design that repeats, like spots, stripes, or zigzags.

**Texture** How something feels when you touch it — rough, smooth, soft, or hard.

**Stone** A hard natural material found outside, often used in art or buildings

**Wood** The hard material from trees that we can use to make things.

**Leaves** The flat, green parts of a plant or tree.

**Clay** A soft, sticky earth that can be shaped and hardens when dry.

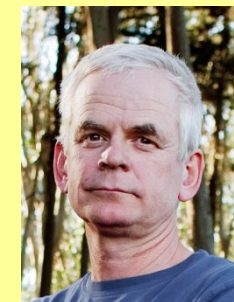
**Circle** A round shape with no corners.

**Spiral** A shape that curls around and around, like a snail shell.

**Sculpture** A piece of art that you can see all around, not flat like a painting.

**Environment** The world around us — nature, land, plants, and animals.

### Artist Andy Goldsworthy

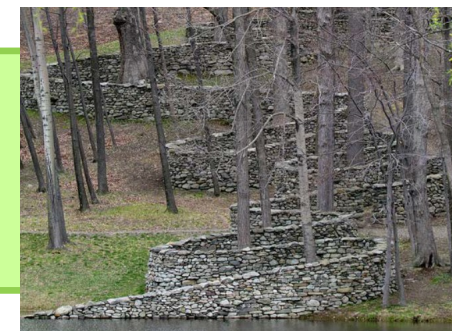


Andy Goldsworthy was born in Cheshire, England. He uses natural materials in his work, like stones, wood, leaves and snow.
