- **Fabric** cloth used to make things
- **Felt** a soft type of fabric
- **Template** a shape to help you cut out
- **Design Criteria** rules the design must follow



Designing

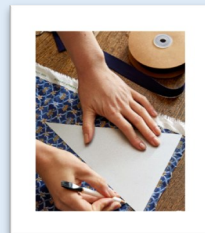
- **Design** a plan for making something
- **Idea Sketch** a simple drawing of an idea
- **Graphics design** making pictures on a computer

Tools & Techniques

- **Cutting** using scissors safely to cut
- **Running Stitch** a simple sewing stitch
- **Joining** (staple / glue / sew) putting things together
- **Thread** thin string used for sewing
- **Needle** a tool used to sew

Evaluate

- **Evaluate** think about how good it is
- **Improve** make something better
- **Criteria** what something needs to have
- **Appearance** how something looks
- **Function** what something does
