## **One World Link (OWL) - the visit to our link school in the city of Bo, Sierra Leone**

Mrs Sutherland and Mrs Garrett have just returned from a really successful and enjoyable visit to our link school in Sierra Leone. There are in fact 15 schools in Leamington and Warwick which are linked with schools in Bo, which is the second largest city in Sierra Leone. Mrs Garrett is the lead person in the UK for the linked primary schools and this was her 8<sup>th</sup> visit to Bo, so we all received an amazing welcome. We visited the other linked schools as well as our own; the links through OWL have been a strength for many years and are now moving into a new phase. OWL are working in a partnership with Educaid, a charity based in Sierra Leone. You can find out more here: <https://www.educaid.org.uk/>

An Educaid worker, JP Sannoh (widely referred to as JP) has been employed to develop teaching in Bo – this is being paid through OWL fund-raising efforts and the contributions from the All Saints' community have been gratefully received. Through this funding, JP is supporting 5 schools in the Bo district through coaching and mentoring to implement more modern teaching and learning strategies. He is visiting all of the linked schools and his work is anticipated to be sustainable as the chosen schools will in turn support the development of others.

This is (initially) a 2-year project and the reason for our visit this year was to look at the difference being made - and the impact was clear to see. As a result, all OWL link schools will continue to fund-raise to support the second year. It was a highly successful visit which included, in addition to the school visits: leading a workshop day for school staff in the OWL centre, a training day for 67 teenage girls in a vocational training school and a meeting at the Bo Education Ministry offices to discuss priorities for training. The Ministry motto is: 'Better teachers, Stronger Nation.' Our work with Educaid is therefore helping to achieve the Ministry and the country's own aims.

We absolutely loved seeing all of the children and have made new friends and many special memories. We look forward to sharing our stories and photos with the children in school very soon!
