Our next PTA meeting will be **Thursday 9th July at 6pm**, venue TBC and will be shared on class WhatsApp groups in advance.



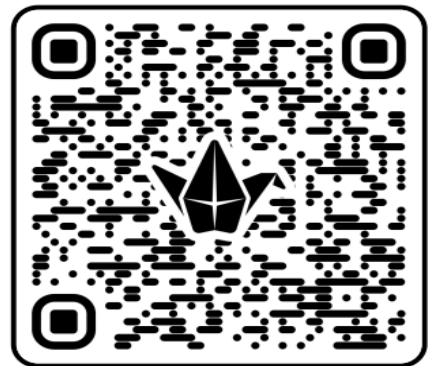
