Important Changes to Instrument Lessons at School

From September 2023, Warwickshire Music will be responsible for the booking and invoicing of music lessons in school. This means if you wish your child to have/ continue lessons in school, you will need to enrol directly with Warwickshire Music. We are pleased to work in partnership with Warwickshire Music to deliver an exciting offer for your child to learn to play a musical instrument.

You can find more information on Warwickshire Music website here: Playing a musical instrument or learning to sing is great fun and helps children to develop self-discipline and confidence. Mastering an instrument can enhance educational attainment and creativity and gives children a sense of achievement. It also has positive benefits on their health and wellbeing.

Lesson charges are as follows: • Shared lesson: £7.38 per lesson • Individual 20-minute lesson: £14.72 per lesson • Individual 30-minute lesson: £22.06 per lesson Lessons are charged termly in advance. Warwickshire Music will provide 33 lessons in term time through the academic year. We are able to offer keyboard, violin and saxophone and clarinet lessons from September 2023.

The Holiday Activities and Food Programme

What is HAF and who can access?

The holiday activities and food (HAF) programme is for school aged children in full time education from reception to Year 11 (inclusive), who receive benefits related free school meals. The programme offers valuable support to families on lower incomes, giving young people the opportunity to access activities with a healthy meal provision over the main school holidays at Christmas, Easter and Summer.

How do I get my child's code?

Codes will now need to be applied for via a brief online form, this is to ensure that they have the correct contact details and the preferred method of how the HAF code is sent, alongside agreeing to their terms and conditions of the HAF programme. This form only takes a few minutes to complete, with a separate form required for each eligible young person. [Complete the form here.](#)

Once they are processed and sent to families, this unique code will last the academic year so there is no need for them to be re-issued for each holiday period. The code will be valid for Christmas, Easter and Summer so keep it safe.

Families who are eligible get 16 days of free childcare over the Summer. You will also receive food as part of the package.

Kids With Bricks After School Club at All Saints CE Junior School

We are pleased to be able to offer our Kids With Bricks after school club running from **3:15-4:15** every **Tuesday** for **6 weeks from 19th September 2023**. This club is open for **Years 3-6** and there are a maximum of 20 places available. About the Summer Reading Challenge

The Summer Reading Challenge is the UK's biggest reading for pleasure programme for children, presented by The Reading Agency and delivered in partnership with libraries. The Challenge encourages children aged 4-11 to keep reading during the school summer holidays. They set a reading goal and can read anything they enjoy! Public libraries issued over 12 million children's books (including eBooks and audiobooks) during last year's Challenge. The Challenge is proven to significantly improve children's reading confidence, making sure they are ready for their return to school in the autumn. It also gives families the chance to access books and fun family activities throughout the summer – all for free. The Challenge reaches around 700,000 children each year, and 75% of children taking part last year improved their reading skills over the holidays.

Warwickshire County Council and Warwickshire Road Safety Partners are offering free Scootability Level 1 training throughout Warwickshire during 7th - 11th August 2023. Training is suitable for children aged 5 – 10 years and is being held at the following locations:

Monday 7th August: Long Itchington Community Centre, Long Itchington

Tuesday 8th August: Coleshill Memorial Park (basketball courts), Coleshill

Wednesday 9th August: Bailey Park, Bedworth

Thursday 10th August: Newbold Comyn Leisure Centre, Leamington Spa

Friday 11th August: GEC Car Park, Rugby

During the course, children will learn essential skills and knowledge to help them scoot safely, including:

- learning about the parts of the scooter and the safety gear
- learning the basics of pushing, balancing and turning
- learning how to do slow and fast stops
- learning how to navigate stationary and moving obstacles
- learning how to do one handed signalling
- learning about road safety rules


