

We hang our coat on our pegs...






- You can purchase a school coat or use any coat.
- Please make sure that your child's coat is clearly named and you could hang a keyring from the zip if it's a school coat, to help your child find theirs.
- They will not need to bring their PE kit into school, but will wear their PE kit all day on their PE days. You will be told about these termly. Usually two days a week.

We put our book bags away...






- Please purchase a School Book Bag. Put your child's name and a keyring on it, so that your child can easily tell which one is theirs!
- Please keep your child's reading folder in their bookbag. So that it is there daily for when we'd like to listen to them read.
- Please get into the habit of checking your child's book bags every evening, looking for letters we have given out. If you need to return a letter, please give it to Mrs Ormandy on the gate, rather than put it in your child's book bag.

We put our water bottles away...



- Water bottles come home daily for a wash.
- Please send them in full of <u>water</u> each day.
 Squash isn't allowed.
- Please ensure it is clearly named and your child can open/close it independently.

We put our lunch boxes on a trolley...



- Willow and Cherry lunch boxes go on the same trolley.
- Please make sure it is clearly named in case there are others the same!

 Please pack a healthy lunch that isn't too big! No nuts or fizzy drinks please.
 This includes no chocolate spread as many contain traces of nut.

Afternoons...

Register, maths, activity time, topic, milk and fruit, story and home.

At home time we lead the children to the Outside Area gate and watch them to their parents/carers. To begin with, it takes some time so give us a wave to help speed things up! If someone different is collecting, ideally email school or tell a member of staff.

How you can help at home over the Summer...

- Lots and lots of talking to your child. Read stories together encourage good speaking and listening skills
- Looking for numbers and letters in the environment
- Help your child to write their first name (not in capital letters)
- · Sharing and taking turns with adults and other children
- Encourage independence at any opportunity zipping up coats, turning clothes the correct way, dressing and undressing
- Put their names on everything (coats, jumpers, socks)
- Toilet train, get a hearing test, eye test as a check up


Why is the PTA Important?

School budgets are challenging


- By fundraising we are able to provide resources to improve the learning environment and complement our curriculum.

- Family Quiz


New ideas are always welcome!

It keeps us busy (but it's fun!)




In the last couple of years we have been spending money on
