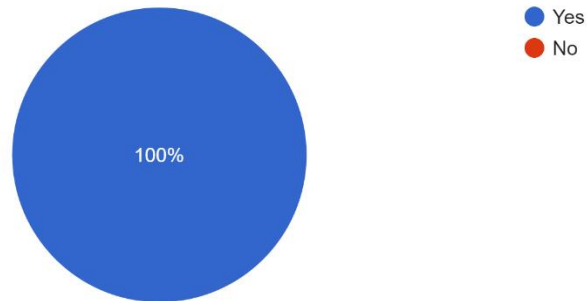

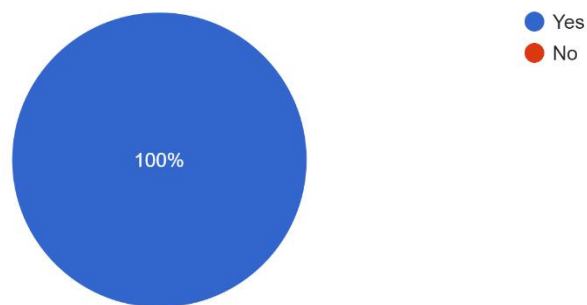
My child is happy at this school.

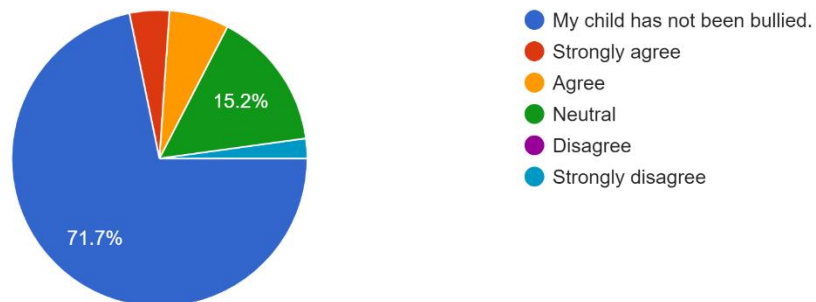
My child feels safe at this school

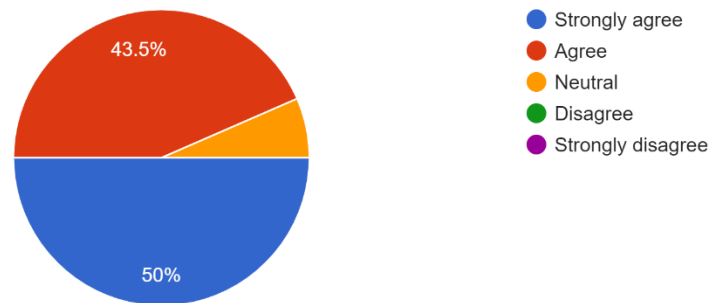
My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively.

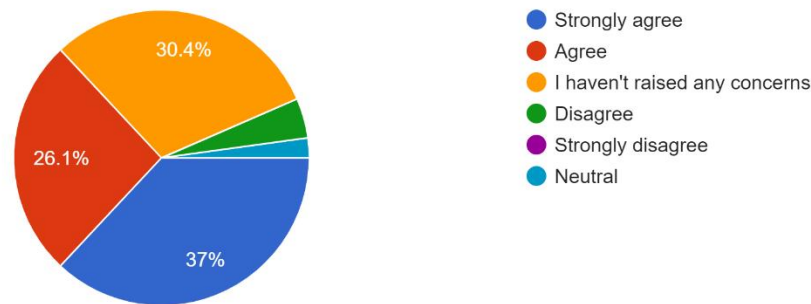
The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year (for example website, topic letters and newsletters).

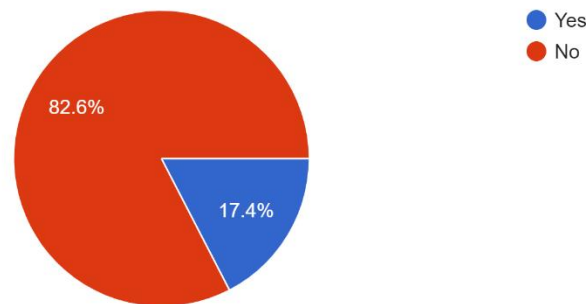
When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly.

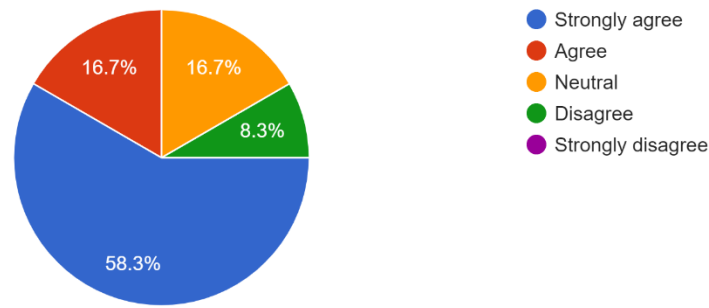
Does your child have special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND)?

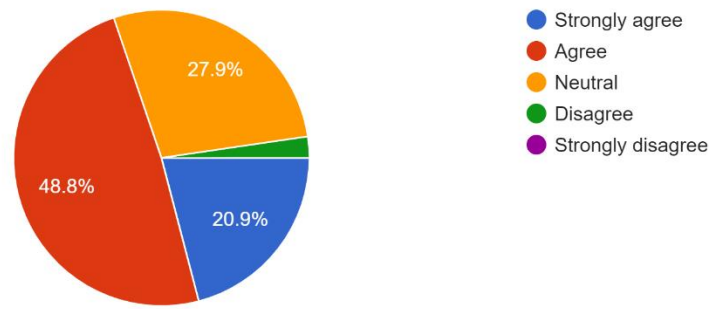
If yes, the survey asks parents how strongly they agree with this statement: 'My child has SEND, and the school gives them the support they need to succeed.'

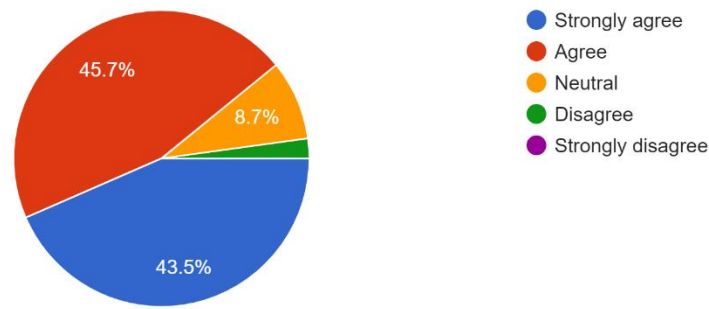
The school has high expectations for my child.

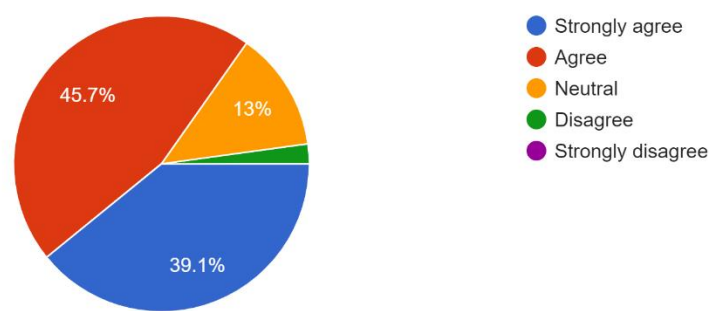
My child does well at this school.

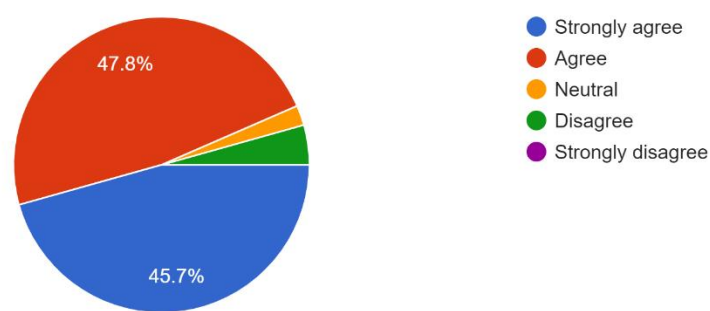
The school lets me know how my child is doing.

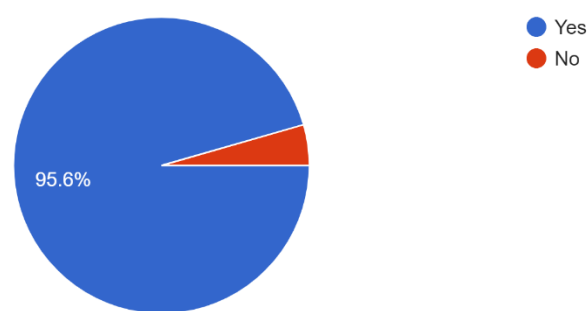
There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school.

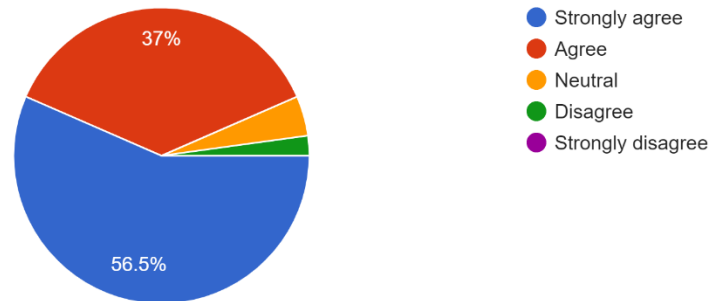
My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school.

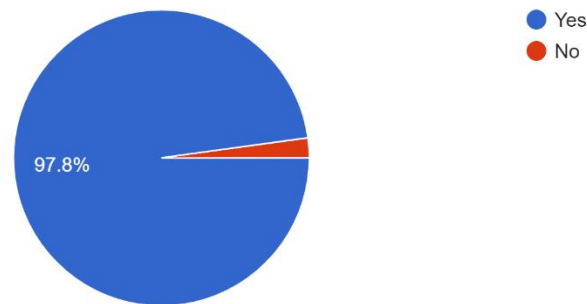
The school supports my child's wider personal development (mental health, growth mindset, spiritual awareness, British Values, RSE (relationship and sex education)).
