## **Dear Parents**

As I am sure, you are aware schools in the local area have been closing bubbles due to positive cases of coronavirus.

If we are advised by Public Health England that there has been a confirmed case of coronavirus (COVID-19) in a bubble this is the procedure we will follow. We hope this helps you to support your child.

## Please remember and reassure your child that for most people, coronavirus will be a mild illness.

We are monitoring the situation and working closely with Public Health England, following government advice which is:

- All children and staff in the same year group will be sent home to self-isolate for 14 days.
- If a child is isolating due to coronavirus we will provide work for them to do at home.
- To carry out a deep clean of the school

The school remains open to the other year groups; they can continue to attend school as normal including other siblings in school.

We all need to remain vigilant by watching out for symptoms of coronavirus. The symptoms are:

- a new continuous cough
- and/or high temperature
- and a loss of or change in normal sense of taste or smell









If you or your child shows these symptoms:

- do not come to school
- inform the school of the situation
- self-isolate with your household
- all siblings must stay at home
- book a test immediately

There are things we can all do to help reduce the risk of you and anyone you live with getting ill with coronavirus:

- wash your hands with soap and water often do this for at least 20 seconds
- use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- wash your hands as soon as you get home
- cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- put used tissues in the bin immediately and wash your hands afterwards
- All adult must stay 2 metres apart from each other

If you or your child have a <u>positive test result</u> during normal school hours please call the usual school office number. During evenings or weekends please report <u>positive test results only</u> by text to 07732387372.
