



Remember to use fronted adverbials and expanded noun phrases. You could even try including a little bit of direct speech!	



Indoor rainbow (clear glass, mirror, white paper. Optional - torch) Following these steps below you can create a rainbow in your home: • Fill a clear glass or clear tub halfway with water. • Place a mirror inside the glass, prop the mirror so that part of the mirror is under the water and other part is out. • Place the rainbow maker glass near a sunny window or sunny place in your house with direct light coming in so that it hits the mirror. • Play around with holding a large white piece of paper above the maker to "catch" the rainbow. You might have to move a bit until you find it or finding the rainbow on a wall near the mirror. Play around with moving the paper closer to the mirror and then farther away to see how your rainbow changes! • Take a picture of your rainbow for remembering later.
