Maths:



In Maths, we will be practising counting to 20 and beyond and thinking about the number pattern after 20. We will be making sure we count every number between 10 and 20. We will also be thinking about the part-part whole model and focusing on number 7 and what it is made up of.



Phonics:



In Phonics, we are learning some more new digraphs.

The digraphs next week are:

'dge' and 've'

Please help the children to find objects in your home or think of objects that begin with these sounds.

Please practise writing these sounds at home too.



Topic:



In Topic, we will be moving onto a new theme – gardening and growing plants.

The children will have the opportunity to plant some beans and learn about what plants need to grow. They will then be watching the plants grow for 2 weeks and then on the last week of this half term, they will be revisiting this topic and seeing how their plants have grown and changed.

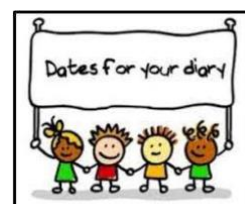
