### **Reading at home**

We would like to let you know that moving forward, you will no longer be required to record your child's reading at home. However, we continue to encourage all families to support their child's reading by aiming for at least three reading sessions per week. Teachers will continue to track children's progress using Accelerated Reader and will closely monitor how often children are taking quizzes, as well as the level and type of book they are reading.

A great way to encourage reading at home is by modelling- reading together as a family is a wonderful way to bond, build literacy skills, and foster a lifelong love of books. Just a few minutes a day can make a big difference! Your support is greatly appreciated.
